NHS pressure - PACT response

PACT is about getting vulnerable adults back home from Hospital as quickly as is safely possible. This addresses bed blocking, alleviates a&e pressures and puts the patients wishes first, avoiding unnecessary admission.

Continuing at the current rate, PACT are creating an approximate saving to the NHS of over £48,000 per month, projected at half a million £ per year - just at the one hospital site alone. PACT is soon to launch in 3 more Hospitals giving the service County-wide reach within 10 months of launch.
